This form must be filled out by the parent/guardian (“you”) of the young flyer travelling alone.

Failure by the young flyer(s) to carry this form at all times or present it when requested by Air India personnel or Air India’s agent may result in refusal of carriage.

- . **You** understand that weather or other events may, in rare instances necessitate an aircraft diversion and/or overnight stay at or away from the point of departure/destination. Some of Air India’s taxi and hotel providers require format written consent in order for young flyer(s) to use their services and/or stay unaccompanied in the hotel.
- . **You** hereby confirm that **you** give **your** consent to the young flyer(s) travelling by taxi unaccompanied and to stay in a hotel room unaccompanied if the rule of taxi provider or hotel provider requires that the young flyer(s) are accompanied.
- . **You** confirm that **you** give **your** consent to the young flyer(s) being accompanied by an employee or representative of Air India. Air India may contact local law enforcement and / or child protection authorities to assist.
