The *Interim Order Respecting Certain Requirements for Civil Aviation Due to COVID-19*, requires that individuals confirm their vaccination status/COVID-19 molecular test prior to boarding. The individual(s) identified below can only travel on board a commercial passenger flight from specified airports in Canada including to an international / transborder destination once they have provided the necessary confirmation under Section 3. This form does not exempt the identified traveler(s) from a random verification of proof of vaccination/molecular test result prior to entry into the sterile area of a specified airport or prior to boarding a commercial passenger aircraft.

  - a. urgent medical situation that does not allow a COVID-19 molecular test to be administered to the person before boarding the aircraft; or
  - b. unvaccinated international inbound traveler authorized to enter Canada under an order made under section 58 of the *Quarantine Act*; or
  - c. a resident of a remote community who:
  - i. boards a flight to an airport in Canada, other than a remote aerodrome, if they arrived by air from a remote aerodrome; or
    - ii. boards a return flight to a remote aerodrome, if they have received a negative result for a COVID-19 rapid antigen test that was performed on a specimen collected no more than 24 hours before the aircraft's initial scheduled departure time, where the Provincial or Territorial Chief Public Health Officer has authorized within their jurisdiction, the use of a rapid antigen tests; or
    - iii. boards a return flight to a remote aerodrome within 48 hours of their original departure time from that aerodrome, if they have received a negative result for a COVID-19 rapid antigen test that was performed on a specimen collected no more than 24 hours before the aircraft's initial scheduled departure time.

as indicated under section 17.1 of the Interim Order and, as such, they do not have to be fully vaccinated or in possession of a valid COVID-19 molecular test before departure.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Each traveler must carry with them at all times during their itinerary the necessary proof to demonstrate, upon request, compliance with the Interim Order.
