



### **Prohibited Articles**

- Carriage of dry cell batteries, knives, scissors, sharp instruments, tools, fire arms, ammunition and their toy replicas is prohibited in the passenger cabin.
- Sporting equipment like cricket bats, golf clubs, ski poles, hockey sticks, pool cues etc. or items that can be used as a weapon, are not permitted as part of cabin baggage on flights operating from airports within India. These articles maybe carried as checked in baggage.
- Carriage of power banks as part of check-in baggage is strictly prohibited. The same can be carried in cabin baggage.
- Certain states and destinations have their own prohibitions and requirements for certain items being carried as baggage. Passenger(s) are hereby requested not to carry any products as prohibited by the local laws not limited to the above. In case of any confiscation at the airport, Passenger(s) will be solely responsible for the same.
- E-cigarette' means an electronic device that heats a substance, with or without nicotine and flavours, to create an aerosol for inhalation and includes all forms of Electronic Nicotine Delivery System (ENDS), Heat Not Burn Products, e-Hookah and the like devices, by whatever name called and whatever shape, size or form they may have is prohibited for carriage, from and/or into India, either on the person, in the cabin or in the checked-in baggage.
