All other passengers viz. unvaccinated, partially vaccinate d (those who have taken only 1st dose of COVID vaccine) and those who have taken both doses ,but have not completed 15 days since the administration of 2nd dose. shall have to produce negative RTPCR report to travel to Port Blair from mainland, as is the practice now. They will undergo additional RT-PCR test on arrival at Port Blair.

All asymptomatic personnel who have been vaccinated with both doses of the COVID 19 vaccine and 15 days have lapsed since the administration of second dose of the vaccine and are in possession of the final vaccination certificate issued as prescribed above, are exempted from mandatory requirement of carrying a negative RTPCR report to travel to Port Blair. Such passengers will be exempted from undergoing additional RTPCR test on arrival at Port Blair airport.
